Many of the projects listed have some form of multimedia to promote their project. Gather a handful of students to help create a video, it could be a great way to promote project based learning. KICKSTARTER

KickStarter: Kickstarter is a website that will host your project and people can pledge money towards it. The timeframe for hosting your project is 60 days, so word needs to get out quickly. The process looks fairly simple to get going. Give it a try today, what do you have to lose?



DonorsChoose: DonorsChoose is specifically for education. The premise is the same as KickStarter. Post your project, promote your project, and get funded. There are a couple teachers in the MRVED that have successfully funded projects through DonorsChoose. With Twitter and Facebook, you can spread the word about your project very easily.
