NEXT GENERATION The second public draft of the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) will **SCIENCE** be available for feedback beginning the first week in January. Although Minnesota is not scheduled to consider changing science standards until 2018, For States, By States the NGSS will have an impact on science teaching even sooner. Publishers and

other content providers will begin to align their materials to NGSS and professional development will use the vision of NGSS. It is important to provide feedback so the standards and related developments support quality science learning. The draft and the online feedback survey will be posted at the NGSS website. MDE will be providing informational webinars to provide background on the standards, explain the feedback process, and hear feedback.
