You can do your own search on <u>CILC.org</u>. At CILC you can search by grade, or subject in the Content Provider section to find a video field trip. There are also some local providers: the Minnesota Zoo (<u>mnzoo.org</u>), Minnesota Historical Society (<u>mnhs.org</u>), and the International Wolf Center (<u>wolf.org</u>) that all offer excellent video trips (search for videoconferencing on each website). Those sites along with the <u>Cowles Dance Centre</u> and the <u>Hennepin Theatre Trust</u> all have special pricing for MN schools.
