COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will have the opportunity to express themselves using a digital camera. During the school year, students will be learning how to use some of the basic functions of their cameras to create interesting photos. We will be looking at functions such as aperture, ISO, exposure, composition, and many more. We will also be working with Photoshop and other editing software for enhancement in student work. Students will take weekly photos that will be reviewed and discussed to help them reach their goals.

CLASSROOM PROCEDURES

Course Length: Semester (Spring only)

Grade Level : 10, 11, or 12

Prerequisites: None

MATERIALS:

- Ipad or computer
- Digital Camera

TURNING IN ASSIGNMENTS

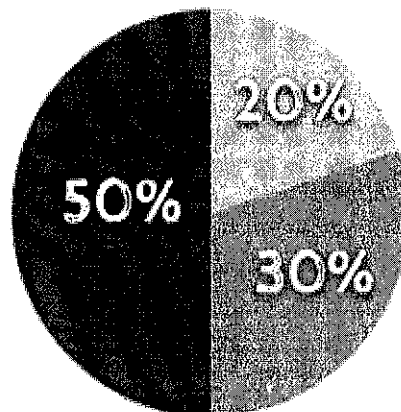
Assignments will be turned in electronically. We will use a program called Moodle. You will be responsible for taking a photo of your artwork and loading it into Moodle.

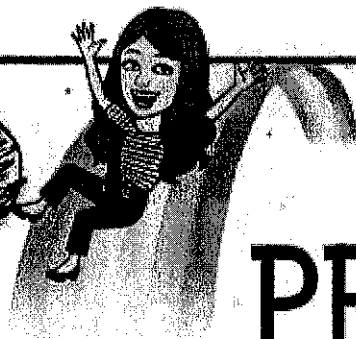

WHAT IS WIP?

Students will receive a Work in Progress (WiP) grade every week. This grade reflects engagement with the art-making processes accomplished in class each week. Students will be responsible for turning in a weekly photo of their artwork in our Google classroom along with a written statement.

WHEN ARE THEY DUE?

Your daily WiP image and statement will be due every Friday.

WRITTEN STATEMENTS

Your written statements should address 2 things.

1. Why you took the picture
2. How does this photo relate to what we are learning

EXAMPLE WRITTEN STATEMENT

I took this photo because it shows good use of shutter speed.

We are currently learning about Night Photography and this image was shot with the longest possible shutter speed without turning out blurry.

WIP PURPOSE:

1. To help increase student engagement.
2. To help hold students accountable.
3. To focus on time management skills.

UPLOADING YOUR WIP:

You may use your cellphones or digital camera to upload your images to google classroom.

HOW ARE THEY GRADED?

5 Day week: Each day you will receive 20 points for the submitted assignment.

4 Day week: Each day you will receive 25 points for the submitted assignment.

Deductions will be made for the following:

- Missing or Incomplete Statements.
- Missing Image of Artwork
